- > We will do DBS checks on all working with Children or Vulnerable adults and those on Church council and will renew every 5 years.
- When recruiting volunteers or paid staff to work with Children or Vulnerable adults we will operate a safer recruitment process
- > Unless we need to, we will keep records for one year
- > We will do Risk assessments for activity in and out of building
- Our group leaders will sign a form to say they agree with Safeguarding policy
- > Other building users will also need to sign to say they will abide by our policy
- > We will provide training
- Nigel Lindsay is currently our safeguarding officer, but we will like someone else to take on this role alongside him. this is administering DBS checks and answering questions
- > THGIRTYONE; EIGHT are our confidential advisors and we will get posters to advertise this

- > First Aid Boxed and accident books will be in Office and Kitchen
- > We will identify someone to be our Social media officer
- > No direct contact with young people unless through parents or with social media officer's involvement
- > We will produce role descriptions for Volunteer roles
